**FY2019 TREATMENT SERVICES SOLICITATION**

**RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED**

**Q) Our location, where substance abuse treatment services are rendered, is located in a county with multiple catchment areas. Our location is within only one of the catchment areas. Can we submit separate proposals in response to the other catchment area Requests for Proposals (RFPs) even though we have no physical location in the other catchment area(s)?**

A) No. The physical location where the potential vendor will provide services dictates which RFP(s) they are eligible to respond to. If your agency only has a location within the confines of one catchment area, then a proposal may only be submitted in response to that catchment area's RFP.

**Q) The "sample" RFP response contains a number of attachments that do not appear to be required by the RFP my agency is interested in responding to, are they required?**

A) The sample is for illustrative purposes only and is for an RFP from another district for a multitude of different services (some of which we are not currently soliciting for). *The sample should not be relied upon for purposes of ensuring compliance with RFP requirements.* Potential vendors should be guided **ONLY** by the requirements for attachments/documentation that are specified in the RFPs for which a proposal is being submitted.
